Classical Actors Ensemble returns to parks this summer with Much Ado About Nothing

Free, Family-Friendly Performances June 16 – July 16

(Minneapolis, MN)—Classical Actors Ensemble (CAE) announces a 9th season of Shakespeare in Our Parks with a new production of *Much Ado About Nothing*. Directed by Producing Artistic Director Joseph Papke, this comedy will be performed in parks across the Twin Cities, June 16 – July 16, 2023, including partnership performances with Franconia Sculpture Park and the MN Humanities Center.

"We're very excited to once again share these plays with thousands of Minnesotans in their local parks," said Joseph Papke. "For many of them it will be their only Shakespeare in the year, and for some, their only play."

Written circa 1599, *Much Ado About Nothing* is considered a stylistic precursor to both comedy of manners and modern romantic comedy. A Prince and his soldiers return from a civil war and bring excitement, intrigue, and passion to a rural town. Callow youths and jaded exes both have their romantic lives complicated by gossip and all is lost—before it's won again. CAE's production will be set in the south of France during the late 19th Century. CAE last staged *Much Ado* in the fall of 2019 in repertory with *Arden of Faversham* at the LAB Theater in Minneapolis.

CAE honors Shakespeare's work by making high-quality entertainment available for all at no charge through its annual Shakespeare in Our Parks program. CAE encourages audiences to bring a picnic to enjoy this free outdoor entertainment for the entire family. In keeping with CAE's aesthetic, this production will include live, modern music performed by the cast.

Previous Shakespeare in Our Parks productions: *Love's Labors Lost* (2022, 2014), *A Midsummer Night's Dream* (2021, 2016), *The Merry Wives of Windsor* (2019), *Romeo & Juliet* (2018), *The Comedy of Errors* (2017), and *The Two Gentlemen of Verona* (2015).

The skilled cast is led by CAE stalwarts Tom Conry as Benedick, Alan Tilson as Leonato, and current U of M/Guthrie BFA students Charlotte McDaniel as Beatrice and Nate Turcotte as Claudio. Completing the cast are Jim Ahrens, Amy Bittner, Dominic DeLong-Rodgers, Bridget Foy, Garrett Hildebrandt, Tim Perfect, Dietrich Poppen, M. Smith Fraser, Jin Suh, and Hannah Twitchell.

Scenic design is by Dietrich Poppen, costumes by Lolly Foy and Molly Smith. The production is directed by Joseph Papke.
