Classical Actors Ensemble returns to parks this summer with Twelfth Night, or What You Will

Free, Family-Friendly Performances June 14 – July 14

(Minneapolis, MN)—Classical Actors Ensemble (CAE) announces a 10th season of Shakespeare in Our Parks with a new production of *Twelfth Night, or What You Will*. Directed by Producing Artistic Director Joseph Papke and longtime company member, Samantha Fairchild, this comedy will be performed in parks across the Twin Cities, June 14 – July 14, 2024, including partnership performances with Franconia Sculpture Park and the MN Humanities Center.

"We're very excited to once again share these plays with thousands of Minnesotans in their local parks," said Joseph Papke. "These plays are for everyone and we aim to make them as entertaining and accessible as possible."

Written circa 1601, *Twelfth Night* is an ensemble romantic comedy and one of Shakespeare's most popular plays. The plot centers on shipwrecked twins who separately wash ashore in a foreign land, each thinking the other dead, and soon become entangled in an unrequited love triangle of noble bon vivants. CAE last staged *Twelfth Night* in original Elizabethan pronunciation in 2014, in repertory with *The Duchess of Malfi* at the former Theatre Garage in Minneapolis.

CAE honors Shakespeare's work by making high-quality entertainment available for all at no charge through its annual Shakespeare in Our Parks program. CAE encourages audiences to bring a picnic to enjoy this free outdoor entertainment for the entire family. In keeping with CAE's aesthetic, this production will include live, modern music performed by the cast.

Previous Shakespeare in Our Parks productions: *Much Ado About Nothing* (2023), *Love's Labors Lost* (2022, 2014), *A Midsummer Night's Dream* (2021, 2016), *The Merry Wives of Windsor* (2019), *Romeo & Juliet* (2018), *The Comedy of Errors* (2017), and *The Two Gentlemen of Verona* (2015).

The skilled cast is led by CAE stalwarts Leif Jurgensen as Toby Belch, Tom Conry as Malvolio, Alan Tilson as Antonio, and current U of M/Guthrie BFA student Nate Turcotte as Sebastian. Completing the cast are John Goodrich, Brandon Herring, Carin Leonard-Gorrill, David Michaeli, Noah Ratgen, Thomas Teeter, Gavin Webb; and featuring talented newcomers Vivian Kampschroer as Olivia and Bella West as Viola.

Scenic design is by Dietrich Poppen and costumes by Molly Smith. The production is directed by Joseph Papke and Samantha Fairchild.
